ADMISSION

- Admission to degree courses is through single window system.
- Applicants have to apply online through the University of Calicut website.
- Admission proceedings to the college will start after the allotment by the university.

RESERVATION SEATS

Admission will be given to physically handicapped, sports and Lakshadweep candidates as per university norms.

ORPHAN SEATS

Orphan students are provided free seats by the management.

RULES

1. Candidates have to submit original copies of the following certificates at the time of interview:
 - Original +2 mark list & Two Copies
 - Original S.S.L.C Certificate for Verification & One Copy
 - Transfer Certificate
 - Conduct Certificate
 - CAP Registration Form (College Copy)
 - Mandatory Fees paid to the University of Calicut (Copy)
2. OBC, SC/ST candidates have to produce a Caste/Tribe Certificate and an Income Certificate.
3. Candidates applying under sports quota have to produce relevant certificates from the Sports Council.
4. Candidates who are eligible for weightage (N.C.C., N.S.S., Ex-Service) should enclose an attested copy of the certificate along with the application.
5. Fees to be remitted immediately after the interview and verification of certificates.
6. Tuition Fees will be as per university rule.
7. College uniform is mandatory.
8. College time is 9:30 am to 3:30pm.
9. Attendance will be as per university rule.
